

WHAT IS A QUIET TIME/ DEVOTION TIME?

1. A time of personal ***fellowship*** with God.
“Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks”. John 4:23
2. A time when God speaks to you about your ***own life***.
“Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts.”
Psalm 139:23
3. A time to commit your ***day*** to the Lord.
“In the morning, O LORD, you hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before you and wait in expectation.” Psalm 5:3

“Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.” Mark 1:35

PRACTICAL SUGGESTIONS:

1. Pick a ***consistent time***!
2. Establish a ***place***
3. Be ***still***
4. Strive for ***consistency*** but don't become ***legalistic***
